

**PTA MEETING

**REVIEW OF MINUTES:**

**TREASURER'S REPORT:**

**PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:**

Principal Brady Stroup reported that the district will cut \$18 million from the budget for the 2010-2011 school year.

The Facility Usage Committee has discussed the possibility of Bell Middle School in Golden becoming grades 6-8 starting next year. This would only affect the Table Rock Subdivision. Residents of Table Rock would have to make a decision to either start their child at Bell in 6<sup>th</sup> grade (leaving Fairmount a year early) or finish 6<sup>th</sup> grade at Fairmount and have their child start Bell in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. A final decision by the committee will be made in January.

**CHAIR EVENTS/ UPDATES:**

Nicki Ball reported that Fairmount has four Destination Imagination teams. There are a few spots left. The tournament is scheduled for March 6<sup>th</sup>. Contact Nicki for more information.
